Joy Cowley is a New Zealand author of children's fiction, novels, and short stories.


Her first novel, Nest in a Fallen Tree, was adapted into the 1971 film The Night Digger by Roald Dahl.

She became a children's writer at the age of 16 when she had a job editing the children's page for The Manawatu Daily Times. In the 1960s one of her sons had trouble learning to read so Joy wrote stories for children with similar learning problems.
