But there was a problem, the hospital had collapsed and there was no roof so they couldn't take the injured people there. The medical authorities had to set up a makeshift hospital in the Botanic Gardens where they could help the injured people. The earthquake was so bad that it damaged more than 200 buildings. Also, some of the water pipes broke. Sadly after the earthquake, Napier had to build almost all their buildings and houses again and it took more than 2 years to rebuild everything which is a very long time.

MY OPINION:

I strongly agree that this is one of the worst earthquakes that ever happened and it's so sad that so many people died and lots of buildings collapsed. It must have been really hard for Napier to build more than 200 buildings again.

If this happens again in Methven then I would be terribly scared.

THE CAUSE:

Did you know that the movement of the tectonic plates caused the Napier earthquake? If you don't know what tectonic plates are then I will tell you.
