BIOGRAPHY (WHO IS OSAMA BIN LADEN?)

Osama Bin ladin was born into a wealthy family in Saudi Arabia, around 10th March 1957, Riyadh. In the 1980s, he went to Afghanistan to help the Afghan resistance (known as the mujahideen), against the Soviet Union, Which had invaded Afghanistan in the 1980s. He then moved to the North African country of Sudan, there he planned attacks on US military. When Sudan's government asked him to leave. He returned to Afghanistan where he was sheltered by the taliban government.While he was in afghanistan he continued to organize and fund terrorist operations and created Al-Qaeda. He allied Al-Qaeda with other terrorist groups like Abu-Sayyaf and Salafia-Jihadia.

PROOF OF LEADERSHIP (WHAT DID HE LEAD?) (WHO WERE HIS FOLLOWERS?)

Osama Bin Laden had created his own terrorist organisation which he funded and led from 1984-2011. He was the one who planned and led the famous incident Hijacking of the 4, 747 commercial aircrafts, the 911 bombing, The Pentagon bombing and the crash at Pennsylvania. His followers were frustrated young muslims who were recruited into Al-Qaeda from Sudan.

On the 2nd of May 2011 just after 1:00am Navy seals breached into his hideout and he was shot.


